

AQUA TAGS – JAIL MINISTRY

An outreach ministry to the imprisoned in the Fairfax County Adult Detention Center.

GIFTS NEEDED: Plain, white No. 10 (business) size envelopes (any quantity) with “forever” stamps applied; bilingual Spanish/English bibles; English or Spanish/English dictionaries.

LIME GREEN TAGS – BRITEPATHS (Formerly Our Daily Bread)

Provides emergency food, financial assistance and mentoring to families that are often members of the working poor. More than half of those served are children.

GIFTS NEEDED: Gift cards for food and other basics from Target, Wal-Mart, Giant and Shoppers Food Warehouse.

CHERRY TAGS – LAMB CENTER

Serves the homeless in Fairfax County with counseling, spirituality and services including hot meals, showers, laundry, clothing closet, computer access, health specialists and legal assistance.

GIFTS NEEDED: Adult-size underwear, socks, belts, t-shirts, thermal underwear, small deodorant, toothbrushes, shaving cream and disposable razors, Smart Trip cards, gift cards to major discount stores and McDonalds.

ORANGE TAGS – BETHANY HOUSE

Operates two emergency shelters in Fairfax County for victims of domestic violence and their children.

GIFTS NEEDED: Gift cards to Giant, Shoppers, Harris Teeter, Target, Wal-Mart or CVS. **For clients’ new homes** – twin sheet sets, comforters, towels, dishes, pots, pans, small appliances, eating and cooking utensils.

- **With the exception of maternity clothes for HOPE and A Woman’s Choice and winter coats for Migration and Refugee Services, all gifts should be new.**

LILAC TAGS – SPECIAL ADOPTIONS

Select a personal gift for an individual, family, foster child or military family in need. Names are given to ST. MARK by social service agencies in Fairfax County and Family Pass.

PINK TAGS – ALTERNATIVE HOUSE

Temporary residences for teenagers who find it impossible to live at home; includes a home for pregnant/parenting teen mothers and neighborhood-based after-school programs.

GIFTS NEEDED: Gift certificates for grocery stores, Target, Best Buy, Babies R Us, Toys R Us, movie passes. For boys and girls, all sizes: hoodies, sweatpants, fleeces, sweaters, underwear. Board games, makeup, watches, twin sheet sets, blankets, clocks (w/o radios), batteries (AA, AAA, D).

PURPLE TAGS – CHO CLOTHES CLOSET

An all-volunteer community organization serving the poor in Vienna, Oakton, Dunn Loring and Merrifield.

GIFTS NEEDED: Men's clothing, especially pants (sizes 32-36); Children's clothing (all sizes); All Ages – new winter jackets (all sizes).

ROYAL BLUE TAGS – HOPE IN NORTHERN VIRGINIA, A WOMAN'S CHOICE

Private, non-profit organizations providing help and counseling to women in crisis pregnancies.

GIFTS NEEDED: Newborns to 2T- onesies, undershirts, clothing, blankets, hats, booties, diapers (newborn to size 5), wipes, diaper bags, bottles, snowsuits. **Children** – toys (infant to age 7), clothing (to 6x), umbrella strollers. **Mothers** - small gifts, maternity clothes, Target or grocery gift cards.

GREEN TAGS – FAIRFAX CASA (Court Appointed Special Advocates)

Trained volunteers work at the request of the Fairfax County Juvenile Court advocating for abused and neglected children to ensure they have a voice in court, do not get lost in the legal and social service systems and grow and thrive in safe, permanent homes. Last year CASA served more than 350 children, 50 percent under age five.

GIFTS NEEDED: Gift cards (\$25 or \$50), which are distributed to the CASA volunteers to purchase inexpensive gifts for the children and teens they serve on birthdays, holidays and other occasions.

RED TAGS – CATHOLIC CHARITIES' MIGRATION & REFUGEE SERVICES

A local affiliate of the U.S. Catholic Conference of Bishops, Office of Migration Services, helps documented families granted refugee and asylee status by the U.S. State Department to build new lives in our area.

GIFTS NEEDED: New twin and queen sheet sets, comforters/blankets, pillows, floor lamps, shower curtains with rings, alarm clocks; new or used winter coats for children (ages 1-13). Gift cards for Wal-Mart, Target, Dollar Tree, Visa, Giant, Safeway, Food Lion and Aldi.

YELLOW TAGS – CHINS (Children In Need of Smiles)

Delivers heartwarming gifts for pediatric cancer patients at Inova Fairfax Hospital for Children, hoping to provide comfort, support and smiles.

GIFTS NEEDED: No-sew blankets (all sizes), all-plastic infant and toddler toys, Fisher Price play sets & figures, small Lego & Lego friends sets, My Little Pony figures, action figures, Barbie dolls, Matchbox cars, personal journals, iTunes gift cards, gas cards or Visa gift cards for parents, activity books for all ages including adults.

LIGHT BLUE TAGS – KATHERINE HANLEY FAMILY SHELTER

Accommodates up to 28 homeless families in Fairfax County, helping them move quickly into permanent housing and then continuing to provide needed services.

GIFTS NEEDED: For the shelter's holiday "Family Shopping Night" for teens and adults – gift cards to Target, Wal-Mart, American Express, Visa and Giant. **Gifts for kids, teens and adults:** Legos, sports team apparel, jewelry/purses, adult/teen board games, household goods.
