WFCM's Food Pantry Summer Intern

Western Fairfax Christian Ministry's (WFCM) Food Pantry serves an average of 350 families every month (representing over 1,000 individuals). Currently, WFCM is the only "choice" food pantry located in Fairfax County. This means that the families who come to our food pantry select their own food vice being handed food that is "pre-bagged/boxed".

Our food pantry shelves start looking quite bare in late Spring. While we have been blessed by regular weekly donors (individuals, churches, organizations & grocery stores) we still need and rely on additional donations of food especially during the late Spring and through October until the Boy Scout "Scouting for Food" Drive in November (which has brought in over 55,000 lbs of food each year for the past several years).

Requirements:

Applicants must be at least 18 years old, enrolled in college or a student who will graduate from high school this year (2015).

Responsibilities:

You will be responsible for contacting local businesses, churches, and community groups who may be willing to hold summer food drives. Once the willing organizations are identified you will coordinate the logistics pertaining to the food drive between that organization and WFCM.

You must possess excellent written and oral communication skills. You will be communicating with individuals via phone, email and providing in-person presentations.

You will be working closely with our food pantry manager as well as the assistant food pantry manager.
